The third, and most serious, is puppy love. Offenders in this catagory will be sentenced to terms of at least six months but not more than four years in an animal shelter.





AACP strives to improve student drinking habits

"We have to promote awareness of alcohol on this campus," said Dandy Dial-a-Drink about the new Alma College Alcohol Awareness Program (AACP).

"Alma College is just too boring. We need something to liven up the atmosphere around here," he added. The AACP is designed to help students with alcohol related problems. These include ignorance of its benefits, inablility to choose quality products and unfamiliarity with the endless variety of mixed drinks available to the college students. "Generally, students at Alma drink in a boring manner. They always choose beer or seven-sevens or screwdrivers. They have no creativity," commented Line A. Coker, another leader of the program. "I'd like to introduce people to a totally new concept of drinking, with such mixes as Revelation Rum, Divinity Daquiri and Virgin Vodka,' she said.

The program will center around private counseling for any problems a student may have. All of the sessions will be kept strictly confidential, and all services are free. However, students must supply their own liquor.

Also included in the program are several seminars.

decided yet. I'm not lying but don't quote me."


However, traffic was stopped on Superior late yesterday as herds of sacrificial cows were moved into the area.


According to Gundy Sachs, assistant dean of students, the cows will be housed in the former Eata Pigma house. "The house is used to animals living

Vice President Dephen Leyer cloned

President Cosmic E. Relic announced today the semisuccessful cloning of soon to retard vice president for finance and leecher, Dr. Dephen Leyer.

"I knew something was up," began Registrar Wilted Potted, "when I saw 'Twinkletoes' and The Bald Bomber embroidered on their academic robes."


The exact cause of the scuffle is as yet undeter-


Bark packs Ratt


Girl ruins Rogers' neighborhood

Hatchet said, "Even though there is a lot of opposition to FAGS, we'd like to sponsor this contest to make the campus as a whole






