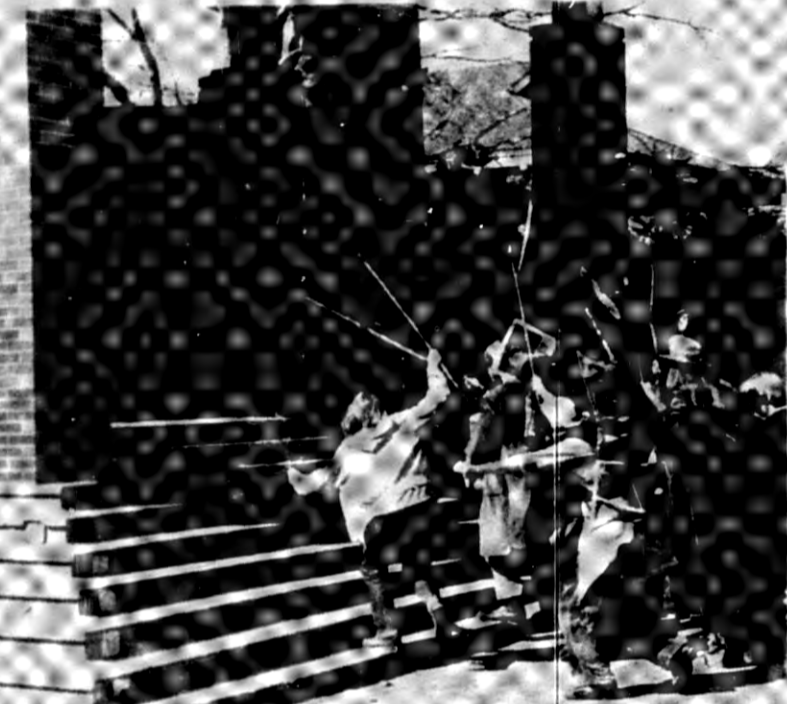
REVOLUTION: WHLA

10) 1208: Field Marshal Cat calls Board of Trustees, order given to reopen Wright Hall.



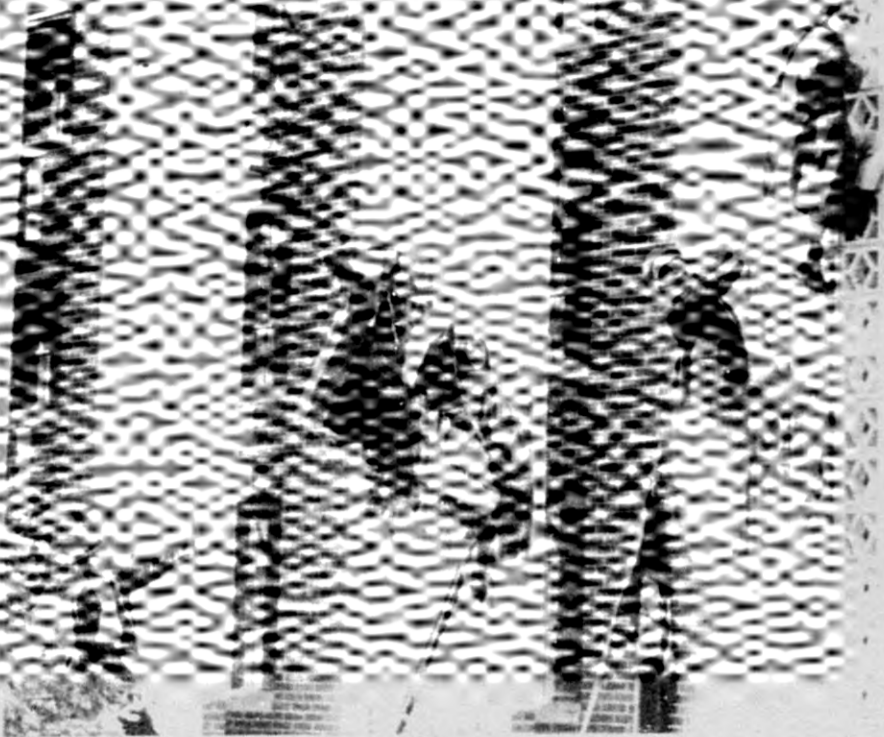
13) 1301: Saboteur Quirk (also the Army's seer) utters oracles of peace from the rock.

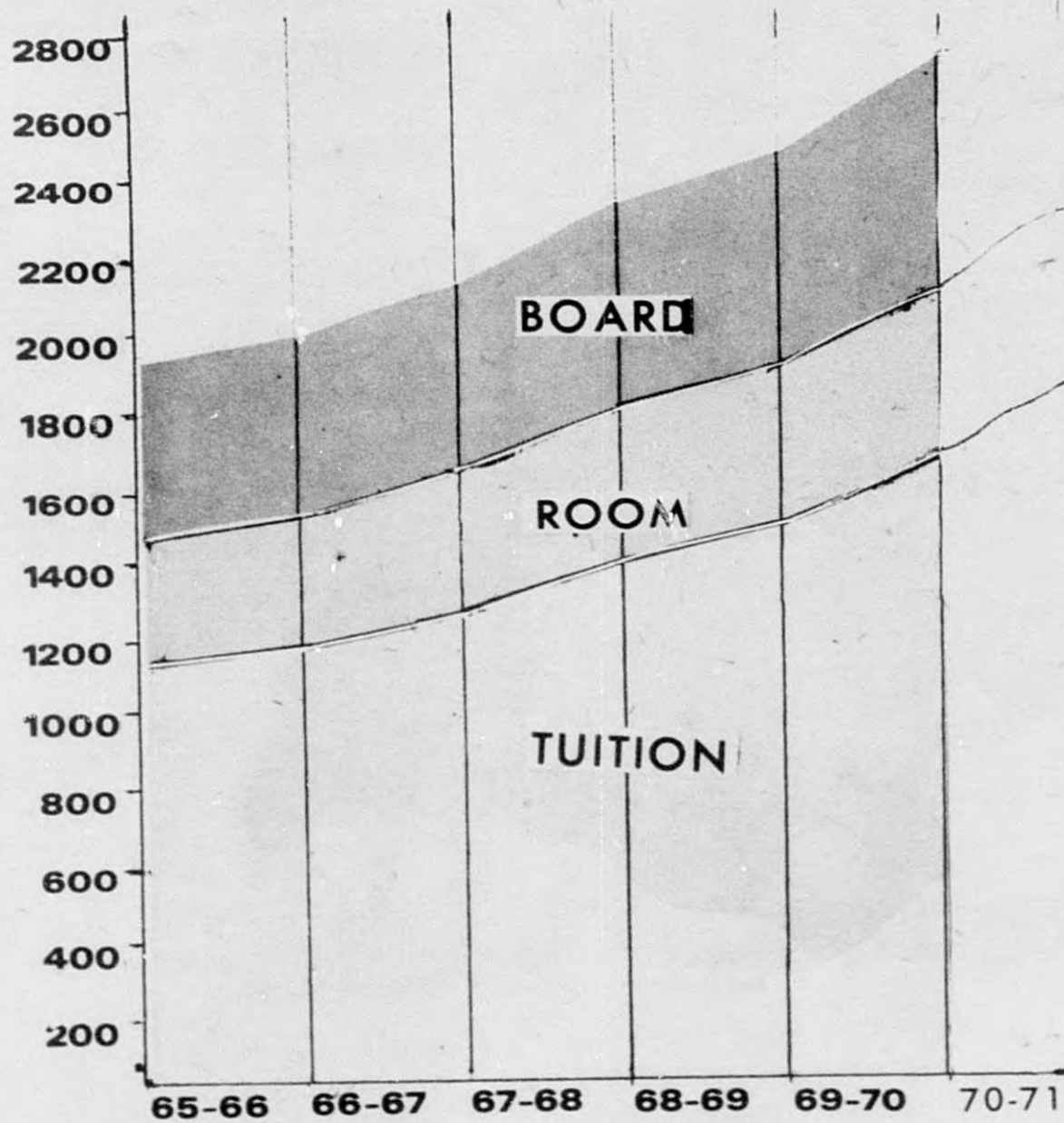
